



For models shooting for the 1st time with BLP on a TFP shoot, the info bellow will give you an idea what to expect.

FAQ:

Q: How long will the shoot take?

A: Most simple shoots take an hour or two. Depending on what you're after, some can last all day. It all depends on how simple or complicated the shoot is.

Q: Can I bring an escort?

A: Escorts or bringing a friend is no problem and encouraged. We want you to be as comfortable as possible. I only ask that they are not disruptive.

Q: How will I receive my photos?

A: you will receive a CD or DVD.

This CD / DVD will have all the best quality photos at 300DPI or (High Res) these can be used for professional quality prints.

Q: Can I get my photos the same day?

A: No! The editing and post-processing takes too long. It can take a week or so to complete but then you get the shots with the cropping, color correction, glamour enhancements etc. It is best to wait for the finished product.

Q: Will I be able to get professional prints from my shoot?

A: Yes! A Print release form will be provided with the CD /DVD. Depending on where you go for prints you may need to take this with you to prove you have the print rights for the photos.

Q: I responded through a modeling website about a TFP shoot to start my portfolio. I want to do fashion or swimsuit on location. Why do you insist on doing a studio shoot prior to any location work?

A: I get an overwhelming response for TFP shoots. I am selective as to what models I will work with. They must be serious about the shoot and I need to make sure they will show up for a test shoot before I pack up all my gear and head off to a location.

Q: You took over 100 photos on my shoot. There was not that many on the CD I received?

A: I shoot all models in RAW format. These files have to be converted to JPG to be viewed on your computer. I only convert the files that are good enough to go on the CD. If you blink or the pose just isn't right or for whatever reason the photo was not up to par I delete it.

Models just starting your portfolio please read this!

Here is a little advice

I tell this to everyone so they are more prepared when they show up.

Before you come to get your photos done, think about the purpose of your portfolio and the demographic you want to reach. If you are just starting out, identify what areas of modeling you want to pursue. This would include but is not limited to the following.

- Fashion, Runway, Casual, Swimwear, Art, Lingerie, Glamour, Artistic Nude

Discuss with your photographer (*That would be me*) what you want to get out of the shoot and what you expect. This way I can be more prepared for you. Having a plan saves time and makes the shoot go much smoother. You will be more relaxed and confident if you have an idea of what you want before you arrive.

If you have seen a pose in a magazine or photo that you would like to try, bring it with you. This is a great way to show me what you want.

Think about the outfits, shoes and jewelry you will bring. Don't be afraid to bring large costume jewelry or over the top outfits. Large earrings, bracelets etc. draw your attention to a photo and can really make it pop. Bring what you look best in and what will bring out the look you are after. Also remember darker colors show less detail. Most dramatic lighting shots are done against a dark or black background. This means you should wear lighter colors for these shots.

If you plan to change your hairstyle or makeup for different shots make sure you bring everything you need. If you have a MUA (Makeup artist) or hair stylist you want to bring that's fine. I can provide one but only for paid work or if the first shoot goes well and we schedule a second, on occasion I will provide one.

Attitude is the most important thing you can bring to the shoot. The term a picture is worth a thousand words is very true. If the attitude is there, your photos can speak volumes. Without it they won't say much at all.

All models **MUST** provide photo ID prior to the shoot.

If any of your photos will contain the following,

- Swimsuit
- Lingerie
- Implied nudity
- Nudity

You **MUST** be 18 or older and you **MUST** provide photo ID before the shoot. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!

All models are required to sign a release form prior to the shoot.
